

A3 The sign is fixed to the stand shown below.




The base and centre post of the stand are made from 40 × 40 softwood.





B5 Orthographic views of a picnic table are shown below.

(a) Complete the isometric view of the picnic table to a scale of 1:10. [12]


(b) One of the joints on the bench is shown below.



(i) Name the drawing method used to show the component parts of the bench joint above.


